- 256. 1 Cor 1:19. God **destroys the wisdom of the wise** and **brings to nothing** the understanding of the prudent.

- 257. 1 Cor 1:20. God has made the wisdom of this world foolishness.
- 258. 1 Cor 1:27. God used **the foolish things** of this world to confound the wise of this world and **the weak things** to confound the mighty things of this world.

 - 371. Gal 3:26. We are all children of God by faith in Christ Jesus. Therefore, we inherit what Jesus created aka EVERYTHIG IN HEAVEN AND EARTH.
 - 372. Gal 3:28. We are all one, and all equal in Christ.

- 373. Gal 3:29. If we are in Christ then we are descendants of Abraham and **inheritors** according to God's promises. **God's promises of blessings** in Deuteronomy 28 **all fall to us**.
- 374. Gal 4:4-5. Jesus was made under the law so that he could fulfil the law and therefore **redeem us**, and we could **be adopted sons of God**.

- 485. Colossians 2:15. **God openly triumphed over Satan** spoiling principalities and powers. 486. Colossians 2:20. **God frees us from the**
- ordinances of the law.
- 487. Colossians 3:1. We have been raised from the dead with Christ and so we should seek those things in heaven.
- 488. Colossians 3:3. We are dead and our life is hid in God with Christ.
- 489. Colossians 3:4 **We shall appear with Christ in Glory**.

- 490. Colossians 3:6 God's wrath comes on the children of disobedience not on the believers.
- 491. Colossians 3:10. We have become a new man in Christ. We are renewed in knowledge of Jesus.
- 492. Colossians 3:12. Believers are the elect of God, we are made holy, beloved by God and he gives us mercies, kindness, and longsuffering (patience).
- 493. Colossians 3:12. **Christ has forgiven us of all sin** so we should forgive others their transgressions against us.

- 523. 2 Thess 2:7. **The mystery of iniquity is hindered** by the **Holy Spirit** until he is taken away to heaven at the Rapture.
- 524. 2Thess 2:8. **God will destroy Satan when he(God) comes back to earth**. He uses the Spirit of his mouth, and His brightens. He dose all of this for us.
- 525. 2Thess 2:13. **God has chosen us from the beginning**, for salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth.

587. Heb 4:16. **God allows us to come boldly** into the **throne room in heaven** and obtain mercy, and grace when we need it in time of need.

588. Heb 5:9. Jesus was made perfect by God the Father,

- **He became the author of eternal salvation** for all that believe.
- 589. Heb 6:7. God sends blessings to all mankind in the form of rain to cause plants to grow so we have food to eat.
- 590. Heb 6:10. God keeps in his memory all of our good works and labor of love.
- 591. Heb 6:12. **We inherit all that is created by Jesus**, and **his promises** to us by having faith in him and patience for it to come to pass.
- 592. Heb 7:18 **Jesus erased or annulled the commandments** because they were weak and could not save us.
- 593. Heb 7:19. The gospel brought a better confidence and expectation than the keeping of the law, because the law made nothing perfect but Jesus made us perfect.
- 594. Heb 7:21. **Jesus was made a better guarantee of salvation for us** than the keeping of the law. Because God the Father swore an oath to declare that Jesus is our great high Priest forever, he cannot die.
- 595. Heb 8:6. **Jesus is the only mediator between God and man**. Not the Pope, or Mary or

- a saint. He mediates a better contract, better than the law.
- 596. Heb 9:12. **Jesus obtained eternal redemption for us** by offering his blood as our sacrifice.
- 597. Heb 9:14. Jesus offered himself that had no spot or blemish and was perfect and without sin as a sacrifice to purge our conscience from DEAD WORKS.
- 598. Heb 9:15. For this cause (Heb 9:14) Jesus is the mediator of new testament (will-inheritance) so that by his death we the believers might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.
- 599. Heb 9: 24. Jesus is entered into heaven itself, to appear before The Father for us. He is our perfect advocate.
- 600. Heb 9:28. **Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many** and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto salvation.
